Re: The Voice of VIEW – the Resolution process 2016-17 - Reminder



In March 2016 VIEW Clubs were invited to select topics for debate at the 2017 National Convention and we are quickly approaching the **submission date of 25 November 2016**.

Steps in making a submission:

1. Clubs or individual members may, if they wish, forward a Resolution at any time during the year up until 25 November 2016.
2. Each motion needs to be supported by a strong and well-presented argument for and, if possible, argument against. This is to ensure that the intent of the motion is fully presented by the Club.
3. Clubs or individuals may, if they wish, provide 'dot points' of concerns/issues to be considered by the Resolution Sub-Committee.
4. All resolutions are to be forwarded either to National Office directly or submitted through your Zone or National Councillor.

In determining the most important issue please consider the 'what' and the 'how' -

- What - you desire as the outcome/s of your motion, and
- How - investigate the necessary process to achieve that outcome.

It is suggested that your Club debate the topics raised, and hold a vote to select the issue it sees as its priority. You may consider involving a local school in this process – perhaps invite a debating team to your Club to conduct a debate on your preferred topic.
