Good morning Ladies - welcome to our October meeting.

With only two meetings to go our year in VIEW has progressed successfully and today we enter into the frivolity of a favourite Australian tradition, Melbourne Cup. I hope you enjoy and join in the fun and thank you for your attention to our theme. You all look beautiful as always!

Perhaps it is fitting that we also acknowledge Anti-Poverty Week- 15th-22nd October which raises awareness of poverty in Australia and how we can work together to eradicate poverty. The Smith Family's statistics inform us that 1.2 million (1 in 6) Australian children and young people are living in poverty. The Poverty line inclusive of housing costs is \$1130/week for a family of 2 adults (where one is working) and 2 dependent children. We know children in disadvantage are left behind in their educational outcomes perpetuating the cycle of poverty later in life. Our mission is to assist in breaking this cycle by sponsoring our 25 *LfL* students. VIEW nationally assists 1700 children.

We also pause and give thought to the thousands of children now left homeless and in poverty in other parts of our world. Thank you for your continued generosity and spirit of friendship and welcome to all. I look forward to welcoming you to our Christmas celebration in November.
