Alison is a Co-founder of STATIONERY AID which was created out of need to recycle excess school stationery items rather than sending them to landfill. They are a public benevolent institution and a community-based initiative that collects, sorts, cleans, renews school stationery items and books that are donated to the most disadvantaged students in need of education resources. In under 2 years they have collected tonnes of unwanted stationery from 34 school collection partners to help approximately 50 schools in Queensland.
