DEBATE on the VIEW RESOLUTIONS RESOLUTIONS 2023

The 'Voice of VIEW' is an important aspect of VIEW Clubs of Australia. Through the National Resolution process, we are able to collectively identify and articulate issues that are considered important for influencing social change in Australia. These are the resolutions on which we will vote at our July luncheon meeting.

- 1. VIEW Clubs of Australia call on the State and Federal Governments to work together to ensure all young Australians have the digital resources and skill they need to fully participate in education, particularly in rural and remote areas.
- 2. VIEW Clubs of Australia urge the Federal Governments to impose tighter restrictions on Sports Betting companies as to where and when they can advertise their products and that all advertisements contain information about the problems of gambling addiction, as done with cigarette smoking.
- 3. VIEW Clubs of Australia call on the Federal Government to increase funding for social housing. Local and regional support networks to address homelessness, the housing crisis as it affects the needs of women and families.



Our SPEAKER for AUGUST will be ALEXANDRA DIGGLES Fellow of the Australian College of Physiotherapists

in the sub-specialty of women's, men's and pelvic health Alexandra started her career at the Mater hospital in Brisbane working on a gynaecology surgery ward. She believes so many women, having surgery for life limiting bladder issues, yet there was no follow-up or prevention.....and this had to change. She explains why she is passionate

about these issues. Bladder issues affect 1 in 3 women and limits quality of life and financial security. There are also good treatment options that many people are not aware of and often they put their symptoms down to inevitable ageing. She is also passionate about improving care and access to care for people, especially women with pelvic pain and ensure no-one is limited by their health at a young age.
