here are some do's and don'ts and information regarding

MASK ETIQUETTE @ KWSC



- Cover your mouth, nose and chin and always ensure you wear your mask when moving around in the room and avoid touching the mask.
- Keep the mask away from you and surfaces once removed - do NOT place it on the table.
- Cloth masks are washable and can be recycled.
- To avoid environmental problems cut off the ear loops when disposing.....resulting in fewer chances of the mask entangling wildlife in the event it ends up in the environment. Single-use masks are plastic-based and non-biodegradable but can be washed and recycled (though health directions do not mention this fact).
- Remember that masks alone cannot protect you from COVID-19. Maintain at least 1.5m distance from others and wash your hands frequently and thoroughly, even while wearing a mask.
