## Terms and Conditions

2. These terms and conditions are the rules that apply to the conduct of the Raffle. By purchasing a ticket or accepting a prize, each ticket holder ("**you**") agrees to these terms and conditions.
3. The Raffle is conducted in Australian Capital Territory, New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia, Tasmania, Victoria, and Western Australia under the following licences/permits:

  7. There are a maximum of 9,999 tickets issued at a ticket price of \$5.00 each

  9. The following persons are ineligible to purchase tickets in the Raffle for themselves or on behalf of any other person:
    - a. persons under the age of 18 years old.
  10. Personal information about ticket holders is collected by The Smith Family for the purpose of conducting the Raffle and notifying the prize winner. If you do not provide us with your personal information, you may not be able to participate in the Raffle or claim the prize. We handle personal information in accordance with our Privacy Policy, which is available on our website at [thesmithfamily.com.au](https://thesmithfamily.com.au). Our Privacy Policy also sets out information about how to contact us, seek correction of your personal information, make a privacy related complaint and how we will deal with any privacy related complaint. Each ticket holder consents to the:
    - a. collection of their personal information by The Smith Family;
    - b. use and disclosure of their personal information as necessary to conduct the Raffle and comply with our obligations in relation to the Raffle;
    - c. publication of their name, as set out in these terms and conditions, in the event that the ticket holder wins a prize;
  12. The draw of the prize will take place at 11am (AEDT) on **Wednesday 7 December 2022** at The Smith Family National Office, Level 17, 2 Market Street, Sydney NSW 2000. The Prize winner will be notified via email, giving particulars of how the prize is to be delivered or collected.

13. Results will be published on [view.org.au](http://view.org.au) website on **Wednesday 7 December 2022**. We will also publish the name and postcode of the winners of all prizes over \$250 in *The Australian* newspaper within 7 days of the date of the draw.
14. The prizes are strictly as advertised and cannot be exchanged for cash. The prize winners are not entitled to any difference between the value of a prize (at the time the prize is awarded) and the recommended retail price (“RRP”).
15. Tickets cannot be refunded or exchanged.
16. Unclaimed prizes will be dealt with as follows:
  - a. if the person who purchased a winning ticket was resident in the ACT, NSW or South Australia and the prize is not collected within 3 months of the date of the draw in which the prize is won, the prize will be subject to a redraw which will take place on Monday 6 March 2023 at 12noon at Level 17, 2 Market Street, Sydney NSW 2000. Result will be published on view.org.au website within 24 hours of redraw.
  - b. if the person who purchased a winning ticket was resident in Victoria, Queensland, Tasmania or Western Australia and the prize is not collected within 12 months of the date of the draw, the prize shall be retained for a period of 12 months after which the prize shall be disposed of in consultation with or at the direction of the relevant authority in that State.

18. All tickets will be purchased online, the ticket purchaser will then receive an email with their ticket/s.
19. We are not responsible for unforeseen technical difficulties in relation to or in connection with the online ticket ordering process. We do not warrant that the online ticket ordering process will be available at all times.

  - a. we are not responsible for and exclude all liability for any loss or damage you may suffer, including loss of opportunity, whether direct, indirect, special, or consequential, arising out of or in anyway connected with this Raffle, you purchasing a ticket or attempting to purchase a ticket in this Raffle, or any prize; and
  - b. we are not responsible for the merchantability or fitness for purpose of the prizes and exclude all warranties, express or implied.
