We provide *Learning for Life* students with the device, data and digital skills they need to participate in the education system and build crucial skills for the future.



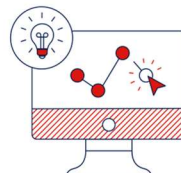
Laptop

A reliable device installed with MS Office to use at school and home for learning and skills development.



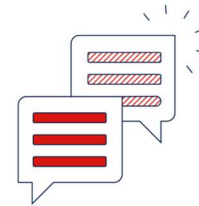
Internet
